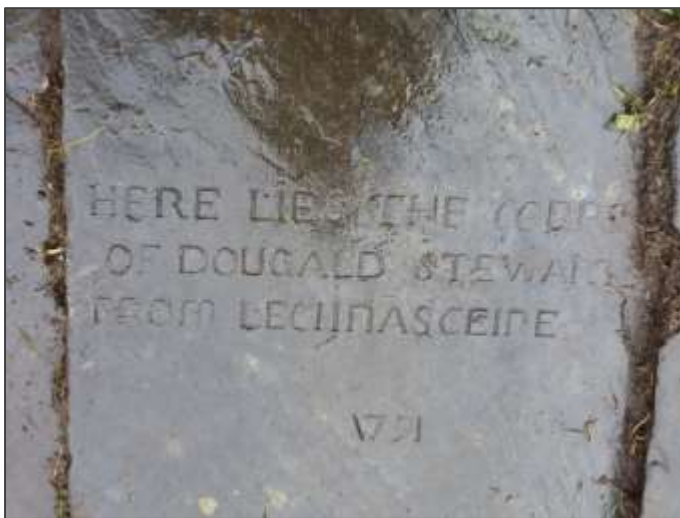

Remarks: A remarkable stone. What a sad story. The second 2 of the dates of death of both Alex and Don^d and the nn of Ann are set back in areas denoting that the inscription has been corrected. Under this stone is another flat stone 75 cm in breadth; length cannot be determined. It is of slate and appears to be smooth but without any inscription.
