Area 1

Monument 1.

(Cargill.1)

Type of Tombstone: Bronze plaque on west wall near south wall. **Location:** Situated 30 cm from south wall. **Dimensions:** Height 20 cm; Width 30 cm. **Orientation:** Facing East **Material Used:** Bronze.

Condition: Good.

Inscription on Plaque

Front:

HERE LIE THE REMAINS OF
JAMES STEWART
"Seumas a' Ghlinne"
WHO DIED 8TH NOVEMBER 1752

"PLACED HERE 1938 BY HIS DESCENDANT DONALD M^CCALLUM, ESQ., KEREMOS, BRITISH COLUMBIA, and JAMES STEWART ESQ. of KEIL"

Remarks: Final line of inscription on bottom rim of plaque and the writing is all on one line. The Canadian town is usually spelt Keremeos.

Monument 2.

(Cargill. 17)

Type of Tombstone: Table on low **Pedestal Dimensions:** Length 192cm; Breadth 83cm; Thickness 11cm. Raised off ground by 10cms at east and 30 cm at west end. **Orientation:** East. **Material Used:** Sandstone. **Condition of Stone:** Worn with some flaking of stone. Inscription difficult to read and decoration not readily visible.

Remarks: His age reads 15 years but I suspect it really was 45 and the 4 has been eroded.

Remarks: Dougald McColl may have been James of the Glen's servant at Acharn.

(Cargill 3)

Type of Tombstone: Erect. **Dimensions:** Height 110 cm; Breadth 48 cm; Thickness 4 cm. **Orientation:** East. **Material Used:** Sandstone. **Condition of Stone:** Worn and covered with much lichen.

Remarks: There is a small, upright stone at the foot measuring 47cms broad by 28cms high and 7

cms thick. It is rough and without any inscription. McCorquodale (sic), Lagnaba (sic).
