(Cargill 57)

Type of Tombstone: Flat. **Dimensions:** Height 200 cm; Breadth 75 cm. **Orientation:** East. **Material Used:** Slate. **Condition of Stone:** Good.

Monument 102.

Type of Tombstone: Flat. **Dimensions:** Length 155 cm; Breadth 35 cm at north end, 25 cm at south end. **Orientation:** North/south. **Material Used:** Sandstone. **Condition of Stone:** Rough.

Inscription on Stone

Front: Near the north end and towards the east edge there is a cross scored in the stone.

Remarks: Because of the deterioration of other sandstone memorials this one has been covered with turf to protect it from the elements.

Monument 102a.

Type of Tombstone: Flat. **Dimensions:** Length 175 cm; Breadth 40 cm. **Orientation:** East/west.

Material Used: Sandstone. **Condition of Stone:** Rough.

Monument 102b.

Type of Tombstone: Flat. **Dimensions:** Length 155 cm; Breadth 60 cm. **Orientation:** East/west.

Material Used: Slate. **Condition of Stone:** Good.

No inscription

Monument 102c.

Type of Tombstone: Flat. **Dimensions:** Length 150 cm; Breadth 55 cm. **Orientation:** East/west.

Material Used: Sandstone. **Condition of Stone:** Rough.

No inscription

Monument 103.

Type of Tombstone: Erect. **Dimensions:** Height 50 cm; Breadth 40 cm; Thickness 3 cm.

Orientation: East-West. **Material Used:** Slate. **Condition of Stone:** Poor, rough.

No inscription

Remarks: This stone is little more than a knobble but may be a grave marker.

Type of Tombstone: Flat. **Dimensions:** Length 205 cm; Breadth 75 cm. **Orientation:** West. **Material Used:** Slate. **Condition of Stone:** Cracked across the middle with some flaking.

Type of Tombstone: Flat. **Dimensions:** Length 180 cm; Breadth 70 cm. **Orientation:** East. **Material Used:** Slate. **Condition of Stone:** Good

Monument 110.

Type of Tombstone: Erect. **Dimensions:** Height 40 cm; Breadth 30 cm; Thickness 4 cm **Orientation:** East-West. **Material Used:** Slate. **Condition of Stone:** Poor, rough.

No inscription.

Remarks: This stone is little more than a knobble but may be a grave marker. The distance to 107 is 150 cm suggesting that this marks the foot of a grave and 107 the head. There does not appear to be any stone between them.

Monument 111.

Type of Tombstone: Erect. **Dimensions:** Height 35 cm; Breadth 15 cm; Thickness 7 cm. **Orientation:** East/West. **Material Used:** Slate. **Condition of Stone:** Poor, rough.

No inscription.

Remarks: This stone is little more than a knobble but may be a grave marker. The distance to 106 is 150 cm suggesting that this may be the head of a grave and 106 the foot. There does not appear to be any stone between them.
