Monument 146.

Type of Tombstone: Erect. **Dimensions:** Length 82 cm; Breadth 23 cm; Thickness 7 cm. **Orientation:** East/West. **Material Used:** Sandstone. **Condition of Stone:** Eroded

Monument 147.

Type of Tombstone: Flat. **Dimensions:** Length 210 cm; Breadth 72 cm. **Material Used:** Slate

Condition of Stone: Rough, ragged edges.

No inscription.

Monument 148.

Type of Tomb: Mound. **Dimensions:** Diameter 140 cm.

Remarks: A low earthy mound, roughly circular in shape. Is this the site of an interment?

Monument 149.

Type of Tomb: Mound. **Dimensions:** Diameter 120 cm.

Remarks: A low earthy mound with a perimeter of stones, roughly circular in shape. Is this the site of an interment?

Monument 150.

'Coffin Steps'

At the west end of the south wall there are a series of large slate steps set into the wall on both the outside and inside. The top of the wall is a large slab of slate. There is an obvious rebuilding of the wall here. The wall here is 100 cm high.

Top Slate: Length 260 cm; Breadth 65 cm; Thickness 10 cm. There are several small initials scratched into the slate.

Inside: Top Step: Length 60 cm; Breadth 25 cm; Thickness 5 cm. It is situated 100 cm from the wall end and is 25 cm below the top slab.

Inside: Middle Step: Length 90 cm; Breadth 35 cm; Thickness 4 cm. It is situated 100 cm from the wall end and is 35 cm below the top step.

Inside: Bottom Step: Length 75 cm; Breadth 55 cm; Thickness 5 cm. It is situated 120 cm from the wall end and is 35 cm below the middle step. It is 35 cm from the ground.

Outside: Top Step: Length 65 cm; Breadth 30 cm; Thickness 5 cm. It is situated 95 cm from the wall end and is 30 cm below the top slab.

Outside: Middle Step: Length 85 cm; Breadth 40 cm; Thickness 4 cm. It is situated 100 cm from the wall end and is 30 cm below the top step.

Outside: Bottom Step: Length 75 cm; Breadth 60 cm; Thickness 5 cm. It is situated 110 cm from the wall end and is 35 cm below the middle step. It is 25 cm from the ground.

On top of this the McColl Stone (q.v.) will be placed when it is returned from Ballachulish.
